PRO	DJECT PHASES
	Look, listen, & observe : Become aware of your community's story and a possible issue, considering low you might <i>go to where the people are</i> to find out their needs.
	Ask tons of questions: Dig deeper by starting with what you know & building on what you have.
V	Understand the problem or process: Research by conducting interviews, reading articles, watching rideos, or analyzing data. As you look for sources, consider how you might be <i>profoundly inclusive</i> . You will be asked for 5 sources with specific links if possible.
	Navigate ideas: Synthesize what you have learned by producing a strategy plan, <i>keeping the community</i> at the center of the work. Link to strategy plan: www.honorsgradu.com/scholarship
C	Create a prototype: Define whether it is a tangible object, digital work, piece of art, or an action, event, or system (if it is an action, event, or system, prepare a short < 1 minute video that shows how it works) Highlight & fix: What's working about your project and what are areas that have or still need fixing?
	Launch to an audience: Share a video reflection (see "multimedia to prepare" section below for details)
